## **INTRODUCTION**

### **HISTORY-**

JAN VIKAS NYAS is a public trust founded by Late Shri Shitla Sahai Ji & Late Smt. Kamla Sahai Ji in the memory of their only son Late Shri Rajiv Sahai Ji. They pledged to give the people of this area, a modern Institute of Cancer. This Trust, which is registered under Madhya Pradesh Trust Act of 1951, started Cancer Hospital and Research Institute, Gwalior in the year 1977. At present this Hospital is recognized by Government of India as a Regional Centre for Cancer Research and Treatment.

In order to provide comprehensive nursing care to patients, School of Nursing was established by the Trust in the year 1985. So far 33<sup>rd</sup> batches are inducted in GNM programme and 34<sup>th</sup> batch will be taken in this academic session 2021-22.

Subsequently Jan Vikas Nyas started a College of Nursing in the year 1992 affiliated to Jiwaji University, Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh Nurses Registration Council, Bhopal and approved by the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and also recognized by University Grant Commission for upgrading quality care in nursing practices. So far 29<sup>th</sup> batches of B.Sc. Nursing & around **1300** students has passed out from this college. Following four batches of B.Sc. Nursing are undergoing training (26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>, & 29<sup>th</sup>) & this year 30<sup>th</sup> batch will be inducted in the academic session 2021-2022.

M. Sc. Nursing course was started in the year 2003 and 18<sup>th</sup> batches have been inducted so far. Around **333** students have successfully completed their Master in Nursing Course and this Academic year 19<sup>th</sup> batch will be taken in this session 2021-22.

As per the felt need P.B. B.Sc. (N) Programme also were started in the year 2010 and 11<sup>th</sup> batches are pass out around **355** students have successfully completed their degree and this year 12<sup>th</sup> batch will be inducted in this academic session 2021-22.

ANM course was started in the year 2011 and 10 batches has passed out, now 11<sup>th</sup> batch will be inducted in this academic year 2021-22.

Students passed out from this institution are presently working all states of India and mostly countries of the world in various positions.

### **COLLEGE CAMPUS:**

- College campus is spread over large area with lush green plants and trees and well-maintained gardens. A big and well-maintained sports ground adds to the beauty. There is enough space for parking. The campus is having continuous water supply through Municipal Corporation and deep tube well. The college campus is having Bank, Post Office and ATM facilities.
- Canteen on the top floor of the hospital as nearby Hills restaurant meets the need of the students.
- Round the clock security is provided to the students both in the college as well as in the hostel.
- The college building is multistory with state of art facilities. Safe Drinking water is available on each floor. Washroom facilities separately for girls and boys are also available on each floor.
- Shri Shitla Sahai Auditorium and Smt. Kamala Sahai Auditorium are available for academic and cultural activities of students with large seating capacity and big stage.

### **TEACHING FACILITIES:**

- Highly qualified and experienced, competent Nursing Faculty according to I.N.C. norms are available.
- Well-furnished and well-equipped lecture and seminar halls are available with adequate furniture and other teaching accessories.
- Well-equipped Nursing Laboratories with mannequins and simulators as per I.N.C. and JHPIEGO standard are available to students to practice clinical procedures.
- Modern audio-visual aids are available. Additional facility of virtual class room is available only in this college in Gwalior
- LCD projector is available for each classroom, Smart classrooms for teaching learning process.

- Advanced Skill Laboratory, it is operational for student's use where simulated training is provided to students in the field of Obstetrical and Paediatric Nursing.
- Advance platform for online teaching and assessment.

### **LIBRARY FACILITIES:**

- The library is well equipped with state of art facilities.
- The library has National and International journals and books over 6000.
- The seating capacity of library is very large and over 100 students can sit and study at a time.
- E-Library has been established.

### **CLINICAL FACILITIES:**

- The college has its own hospitals, Cancer Hospital & Research Institute and Shitla Sahai Institute of Medical Sciences (SSIMS) Hospital with round the clock emergency facilities.
- Shitla Sahai Institute of Medical Sciences (SSIMS) Multi specialty hospital is 125 bedded and CHRI is 256 bedded Hospital.
- Besides this affiliated hospitals are 1332 bedded J.A. Hospital and Gajra Raja Medical College, Gwalior (M.P.) and 250 bedded Mansik Arogya shala, Gwalior (M.P.)
- M.Sc. (N) students avail clinical facilities at Central institute of Psychiatry Kanke Ranchi, Jharkhand and NIMHANS Bangaluru.
- Students are trained in all specialities intensively.

### **COMMUNITY HEALTH NURSING TRAINING:**

- Students avail clinical skills in the field of community health nursing at Primary Health Centre Barai and Community Health Centre Mohna and have adopted Slum Area Guda Gudi Ka Naka, Gwalior.

### **COMPUTER EDUCATION:**

- P.G. College of Nursing has well developed Computer laboratory with internet facility and 30 students can have computer training at a given time.
- Regular classes are taken by specialized teacher regarding computer science & computer applications in nursing.

### **EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:**

- Debates, Essay competition, Dance & Drama are being regularly organized; Students participate at the District, State and National level competitions; Seminars are also held on World Health Organization Day, World Mental Health Day, Cancer Day, Breast Feeding Week, AIDS day, Anti-tuberculosis Day, Nurses Day etc.
- Students participate in SNA conferences at college and National level.
- **SPORTS FACILITIES:** - There are facilities for Indoor and Outdoor games, sports competition is held during annual sports meet, students take part in Inter College competitions, organized by University and other Institutions. Students also participate in National level competitions.
- **CULTURAL ACTIVITIES:** - Students from all the states perform various folk dance, on various occasions in the college as well as in the city of Gwalior on special invitation.
- **NCC ACTIVITIES:** - The NCC unit was started on April 2019 under the supervision of Col. M.S. Chahal with 54 Cadets from B.Sc. Nursing & GNM students of Post Graduate College of Nursing, Gwalior. Out of 54 Cadets 35 Cadets are completed B Certificate camp & waiting for final exam. Recently 17 Cadets were selected for B Certificate camp & exam from 20-21 batch of B.Sc.(N) & GNM. Ms. Pooja Ahirwar (Asst. Prof.) is working as a Care Taker of NCC Cadets. Mr. Munesh Rajak (Sports Officer) assisting the Care Taker.

### **HOSTEL FACILITIES:**

- Hostels are available with all mandatory facilities like big corridors and Verandas. Adequate water supply is provided continuously. INC and University standards are followed for all the hostel facilities. Separate sick room, entertainment room and visitor lounge are available. Round the clock armed security is available and lady warden remains present for 24 hours.
- Each living room has attached bathroom and separate balcony to dry clothes.

- The premises are surrounded by high-up compound wall, beautiful gardens and big open space.
- Each student is provided separate Cot, Almirah, Table and chair for their boarding and studying.
- **Hostel Mess** is available in same hostel building with all the food hygiene standards.
- Cafeteria facility is also available for Meal and Snacks.

### **GUIDANCE & COUNSELING:**

- Students are guided and counseled regularly for professional and personal conflicts by member of counseling committee and experienced teachers throughout the year. A homely atmosphere is maintained in hostel and college campus for the students. If any problem arises, concerned class teacher and principal give necessary guidance and counseling as and when needed.

### **MEDICAL FACILITIES:**

- Free medical checkup, consultation and treatment are available in the parental Hospital.
- As per our policy we used to conduct health check up of all new admitted students of all courses and immediately as per felt need of any students.

### **TRANSPORT FACILITIES:**

- College Buses are available for transportation of students to various institutions and clinical fields.
- Recently one more bus is purchased for students.

### **YOGA CLASSES:**

- Regular yoga classes are provided to students by Yoga teacher that helps students to maintain better health both physical and psychological. It also helps in maintaining concentration during studies.

### **CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF CANDIDATES (As per rules of State Govt.): -**

- The selection of candidates for the course will be done by the selection committee on the basis of entrance examination and Personal Interview.
- 16 % for candidates of Schedule cast.
- 18 % for ST Category.
- 14 % for OBC Category.
- For disabled candidates 5% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 45% to 50% of lower extremity & other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for each nursing programme.
- Subject to production of valid certificate from competent authorities. Vacant seats if any shall be filled up from the candidates of general category.

### **FEES & OTHER CHARGES:**

- ☐ Fee varies as per the course chosen. Fees should be paid in two installments as follows-
  - (i) 1st 50% at the time of admission.
  - (ii) 2nd installment will be deposit through online by the month of March 2022.
- ☐ Actual fee amount is mentioned under each course details.
- ☐ Penalty for Late Fees: - From April 2022 and onwards fine will be applicable as per the institutional policy.
- ☐ College Fee will be deposit through online mode in two installments for other running batch. (<https://eps.eshiksa.net/>)
- **Fee once deposited will not be returned back in any how condition.**
- Candidates may have to pay fee to avail clinical experience in affiliated hospitals.
- Other charges like Uniform, Record Books, SNA, TNAI & other miscellaneous expenditure at the time of requirement have to be paid by the students.
- University / Council Enrollment fees should be paid at the time of enrollment.
- University / Council examination fees to be paid separately at the time of the filling examination forms.

### **DISCIPLINE:**

All the students will have to abide strictly by the rules and regulations of the College and the hostel, as enforced from time to time. Any violation will be strictly dealt with. Managing Trustee reserves the right to



rusticate students who are found indulging in acts prejudicial to the interest of the Institution and welfare of other students. If any damage done by student; it is recovered from caution money.

### **UNIFORM:**

The candidate admitted for studies are required to wear the uniform approved by the Institution's rules. Uniform is compulsory throughout the course both in college and clinical duty.

### **VACATION:**

- Vacations are given to students as per INC recommendations, university directive and Institutional Policy.
- No extra leave will be granted during the training, except the prescribed leave.

### **REGULATIONS:**

- Every student admitted to any Nursing course shall have to follow rules and regulations of the P.G. College of Nursing
- Every Student will have to attend classes and practical work regularly as per the University / Council requirement.
- In case of illness, permission shall have to be obtained from the Principal to remain absent from studies.
- Rules and regulations of the hostel shall have to be followed and instructions of the Warden, Asst. Warden and Mess Incharge will have to be adhered too.
- Local Guardian Form should be filled in all the details and signed by the parent. Student will not be permitted to go on leave / night out pass until unless local guardian as authorized by parents comes and takes her.
- The local guardian can see their ward on Sunday only. In case of emergency, special permission shall have to be obtained from the warden.
- Students are advised to complete their clinical dues (if any) during vacation period.
- Students have to maintain 80% attendance separately in theory and 100% in each clinical area. Hence attendance also to be completed separately in each theory class and clinical practice.
- **RAGGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED AND IS A PUNISHABLE OFFENCE.**
- In case of any dispute, decision of the Managing Trustee will be final.

### **POLICY & NORMS OF COLLEGE FOR OVERALL ASSESSMENT OF STUDENTS OF ALL COURSES**

## **AUXILIARY NURSE AND MIDWIFERY COURSE (ANM)**

### **ADMISSION CRITERIA:**

1. The Minimum age for admission shall be 17 years (Year of birth must be before 2005) on or before 31st of December of the year in which admission is sought.
2. The Maximum age for admission shall be 35 years.
3. The Minimum educational requirement shall be 10+2 in Arts (Mathematic, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology & Philosophy) & English core/English elective or Science or Health care Science, Vocational stream only passing out from recognized board.
4. Student qualified in 10+2 arts or science examination conducted by NIOS. (National Institute of Open School)
5. Student shall be admitted once in a year.
6. Student shall be medically fit.
7. Category relaxation as per state govt. rules.

### **MEDICAL FITNESS:**

Admission is subjected to satisfactory medical examination report.

### **DURATION OF COURSE:**

2 years duration of course.

Selection of candidates shall be based on personal interview conducted by the selection committee of the institution.

## **GENERAL NURSING & MIDWIFERY (GNM)**

### **ADMISSION CRITERIA:**

- Minimum and Maximum age for admission will be 17 year (Year of birth must be before 2005) and 35 years. There is no age bar for ANM/LHV.
- Minimum education:
  - 10+2 class passed preferably Science (PCB) & English with aggregate of 40% marks.
